Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and infact there are no specific overt acts against the petitioner to attract the alleged offence under Section 498 and 506 of IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the D.P. Act. He submits that all the allegations are made against the other accused and infact the petitioner has filed divorce O.P. in which notice was issued to the complainant on 23.01.2021. Thereafter the complainant filed a report on 18.03.2021 as an after thought. He submits that initiation of criminal proceedings against the petitioner is pure abuse of	

		process of law and hence, the FIR needs to be quashed. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case where there are no specific overt acts against the petitioner, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in FIR No.54 of 2021 of T.Sundupalli Police Station, Y.S.R.
