ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking the following relief:

“to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the name of Writ of Mandamus and declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 & 3 are bad, arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional and against the Principles of Natural Justice and violation of Articles 14, 19 of the Constitution of India and consequently issue direction to Respondent No.1 & 2 to dispose off Petitioner’s appeal/representation dated 4-12-2023 and with regard to dismissal order passed against Petitioner by principal, Police

Training College-Ananthapur vide dismissal order
Proceedings in RC No.01/PR/2011-18 00 No.05/2018 Dt.
11-1-2018 and pass such other order or orders ...”

2. Heard Sri B. Simhachalam, learned Advocate, representing Sri S. Siva Shanker, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri S. Raju, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services – I, for the respondents.

3. The matter was listed on 02.07.2024 and it was adjourned at the request of learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I, enabling him to get instructions regarding the status of the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 11.01.2018, passed by the Principal, Police Training College, Ananthapuramu *vide* Rc.No.01/PR/2011-18.

4. Today, when the matter is taken up, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I, produced a copy of the order, dated 22.07.2024 passed by the Inspector General of Police (Personnel), Andhra Pradesh, Mangalagiri *vide* D.Dis No.1615/T3/2023, whereby the appellate authority rejected the appeal, while confirming the punishment imposed by the Disciplinary Authority.

5. Copy of the said order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In view of the subsequent developments, pending the writ petition, cause in this writ petition does not survive.

7. Hence, this writ petition is closed giving liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 22.07.2024 passed by the Inspector General of Police (Personnel), Andhra Pradesh, Mangalagiri, *vide* D.Dis No.1615/T3/2023. No costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
