Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the
circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be
pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in
the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents,

especially Respondents No.3 to 5 in repeatedly and frequently calling the Petitioner to the Police Station, despite compliance with the bind-over proceedings and in the absence of any fresh complaint, FIR, or legal basis, as illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional. Consequently, direct the Respondents not to interfere with the personal liberty of the Petitioner except in strict adherence to the procedure established by law.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents, particularly Respondent No.3 to 5, not to summon or compel the presence of the Petitioner to the Police Station in connection with any alleged enquiry, except by following the due procedure established under law and by issuing notice strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Pending disposal of WP 14143 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. VASAVI RATNA KUMARI DANDAMUDI, Advocate for the Petitioner, learned GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1 to 6, the Court made the following **ORDER:**

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home sought further time for getting instructions.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026.

In the meantime, the respondent/police are directed not to interfere with the personal life and liberty of the petitioner, without following the due process of law.

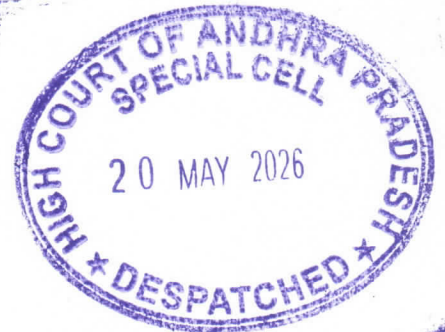
