This Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed for the following relief:

*“...to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or direction declaring the action of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respondents in blocking the lease ID 0121030116 in E-Permit System of www.minesap.gov.in Portal for the quarry lease for colour granite of the petitioner over an extent of 5 hectors in Sy.No.01 of Addukonda Village, Tekkali Mandal, Srikakulam District even though the lease area is 5 hectors and EC is not applicable as illegal, arbitrary and consequently direct the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respondents to unblock the lease ID of the petitioner and pass..”*

OMR Law Firm, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in view of the subsequent events taken place in the *lis*, the cause in the Writ Petition does not survive for further adjudication and the Writ Petition has become infructuous.

4. Recording the submission made by learned counsel for petitioner, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. There shall be no orders as to costs.
