Petition under Section 482 of Cr.PC, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in Crl.P., the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the arrest of the petitioner/A-13 in Cr.No. 833 of 2021 of Madanapalle I Town Police Station, in the interest of justice, pending disposal of Crl.P.No. 4359 of 2021 on the file of High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and memo of grounds filed in Crl.P., upon hearing the arguments of Sri Chetluru Sreenivas, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of the Public Prosecutor on behalf of respondent No.1/State, the Court made the following

ORDER :-

"Heard.

The criminal petition is filed to quash the proceedings in FIR No.833 of 2021 of I Town Police Station, Madanapalle, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 166, 167, 467, 471, 409 and 420 read with 34 of IPC basing on a report lodged by the Tahsildar, Madanapalle Mandal, Chittoor District in view of news item published in Andhra Jyothi Daily Newspaper in which the petitioner is arrayed as A13.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is working as Deputy Tahsildar and the complaint is lodged on the ground that accused restored the digital signature of Tahsildar. He submits that as far as the petitioner is concerned, it is alleged that he has forwarded the application to the Village Revenue Officer to verify and put up. It is also stated that the Village Revenue Officer has recommended for restoration of digital signature without placing the same before the petitioner. He submits that except this allegation there are no specific overt acts against the petitioner and even if all the allegations are taken on its face value, no offence is made out against the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the allegations in the report where there are no specific overt acts against the petitioner, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in FIR No.833 of 2021 of I Town Police Station, Madanapalle, Chittoor District as far as the petitioner is concerned, until further orders. "
