The present Writ Petition is filed questioning the action of Respondent/University in demanding fees towards Research Journal fees from the Petitioner/Institution, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. This Court, following the interim order passed in W.P.No.5740 of 2018, extended the similar order. Subsequently, on 15.03.2024, the W.P.No.5740 of 2018 was dismissed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court on the ground that the cause of action does not survive, as the issue pertains to the year 2018.

3. In view of the same, for the said similar reasons, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, pending applications, if any, shall stand closed.
