Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent University in orally demanding that the petitioner institutions to pay amounts in the form of University Service Fee from students over and above the fee fixed by the Govt. of A.P through the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) as illegal, arbitrary and violative of provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 and without authority and consequently direct the Respondent university not to insist for any service fee or any other fees that without there being any approval and orders from Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) and without following any due process of law and consequently direct the respondent to issue affiliations every year without insisting University service fees.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2020**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent to issue affiliation for the academic year 2019-20 to the petitioner institutions without insisting the petitioners to pay the University Services Fee, pending disposal of WP 18145 of 2020, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B Chandrasen Reddy Advocate for the Petitioners, and Sri T.S.N. Sudhakar, learned Standing Counsel for the respondent, and the Court made the following.

**ORDER:**

**"Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri T.S.N. Sudhakar, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent.**

**Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issues raised in this case are similar to batch of writ petitions, wherein interim orders are being granted from time to time. He placed reliance on the orders passed in W.P.No.5740 of 2018, dated 21.02.2018, W.P.No.4875 of 2018, dated 15.02.2018 and also latest orders passed in W.P.No. 17028 of 2019.**

**Following the same and for the reasons recorded therein, there shall be an interim direction as prayed for.**
