Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, or Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.4 in issuing notices dated 21-10-2024, 16-5-2025 under the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Land Encroachment Act and Proceedings in R.C.No.339/2024/C.SA/dated 23-5-2025 and threatening the Petitioner to dispossess from the land an extent of Ac.0.12 cents covered by Sy.No.56-1 situated at Chintalaveedhi Village, Paderu Mandal, Alluri Seetharamaraju District, as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional, against to principles of natural

justice and contrary to the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Land Encroachment Act, 1905 and rules made thereunder.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to dispossess the Petitioner from the land an extent of Ac.0.12 cents covered by Sy.No.56-1 situated at Chintalaveedhi Village, Paderu Mandal, Alluri Seetharamaraju District, Pending disposal of WP 14083 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI BOLLA VENKATA RAMA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR REVENUE, for the Respondents, the Court made the following

ORDER:

The petitioner is aggrieved by the notice dated 23.05.2025, which was issued to threatening to dispossess the petitioner from the land admeasuring to an extent of Ac.0.12 cents covered by Sy.No.56-1, Chintalaveedhi Village, Paderu Mandal, Alluri Seetharamaraju District.

In so far as the possession of the petitioner is concerned, both the parties are directed to maintain status-quo.

The learned Government Pleader for Revenue, is directed to inform the concerned about the passing of this order.
