Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or proceeding or writ more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the declaring action of the respondent authorities in not granting Form-2B license to the petitioner in the premises i.e., Door No.74/132, built-up circle, Kadapa Municipal Corporation, YSR District pursuant to the provisional license issued by the 4th respondent

dt.18.09.2025 as illegal, arbitrary, violation of principles of natural justice and in contrary to the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Excise (grant of license of selling by Bar and conditions of license) Rules, 2025 and consequently direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to continue the business at premises Door No.74/132, built-up circle, Kadapa Municipal Corporation, YSR District by granting Form- 2b license to the petitioner;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to continue the business at premises Door No.74/132, built-up circle, Kadapa Municipal Corporation, YSR District by extending the provisional license granted to the petitioner, Pending disposal of WP 14463 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri C SUBODH Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR PROHIBITION EXCISE for Respondent Nos.1 to 5 and the Court made the following.

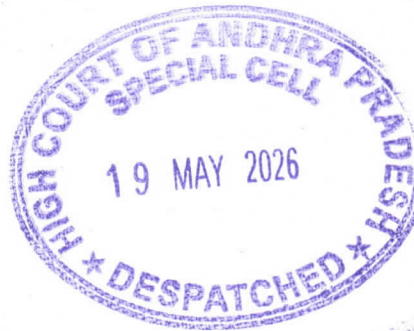
