WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI V CH NAIDU presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction

more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents 2 to 6 in not taking any action on the illegal digging of prawn tanks (aquaculture tanks) by the Respondent No.7 in the lands known as VANPIC lands situated adjacent to the Petitioner's agriculture lands admeasuring Ac.13-02 cents in Sy.Nos.239/1 and 239/3 situated at Pullaripalem Village, Vetapalem Mandal, Bapatla District, by considering the Petitioners Representation dated 24.4.2026 and Grievance Application No.BPT202604275831, dated 27.4.2026, as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and further direct the Respondents to take action against the illegal digging of prawn tanks (aquaculture tanks) by considering the Petitioners Representation dated 24.4.2026 and Grievance Application No.BPT202604275831, dated 27.4.2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V CH NAIDU Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Revenue for Respondent Nos.1, 2, 5 & 6, GP for Fisheries for Respondent Nos.3 & 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim direction directing the Respondents 2 to 6 to immediately stop the illegal digging of prawn tanks (aquaculture tanks) by the 7th Respondent by considering the Petitioners Representation dated 24.4.2026 and Grievance Application No.BPT202604275831, dated 27.4.2026, pending disposal of the above writ petition and pending disposal of WP No. 14491 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent Nos. 1, 2, 5 and 6, and the learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing for respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

Issue notice to respondent Nos. 7 and 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos. 7 and 8 through Registered Post Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service before the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be an interim direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 6 to prevent the illegal digging of prawn tanks (aquaculture tanks) by the 7th respondent by considering the representation dated 24.04.2026 and the grievance application dated 27.04.2026 submitted by the petitioner, pending disposal of the writ petition.

List the matter after the Summer Vacation, 2026.

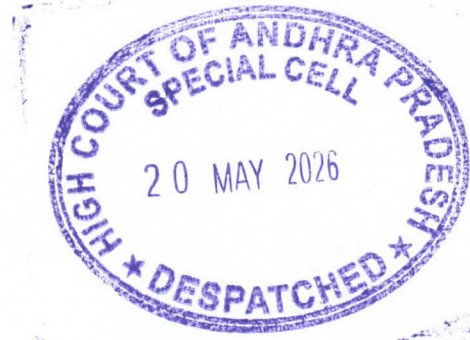
