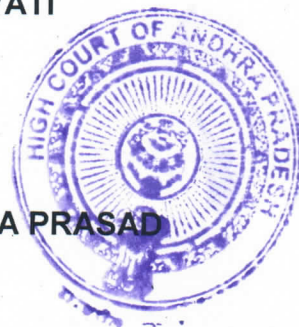

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the rejection of the online application submitted through Mee Seva with Application No.RMU011801316154, dated 19-10-2018 by the respondent No.4 without mentioning any reasons eventhough the same is my private Patta land as arbitrary, illegal, colorble exercise of power, apart from being violative of fundamental rights guaranteed to me under Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.4 to Mutate my name in the revenue records and also to issue Pattadar Pass Books and Title Deeds in my favor by setting aside the rejection order, dated 19-10-2018 passed by the respondent No.4.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the rejection of my online Application No.RMU011801316154, dated 19-10-2018 passed by the respondent No.4 and direct the respondent No.4 to consider the application afresh and pass reasoned order on merits, pending disposal of WP 12860 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P V N Kiran Kumar, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for the Respondents, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

“Certain directions were issued by this Court while disposing of an earlier writ petition filed by the present writ petitioner in a Writ Petition bearing W.P.No.440 of 2013 dated 25.02.2014.

It also transpires from the record that the directions of this Court dated 25.02.2014 have attained finality. It transpires from the record that in pursuance of the said directions, the writ petitioner had approached the authority and that by order dated 19.10.2018 (impugned order) the application of the writ petitioner has been rejected. It transpires from the impugned order that it is a non-speaking order and that it is not indicative that the directions given by this Court on the earlier occasion have been taken into consideration.

In this view of the matter the respondent No.4 is directed to consider the material on record including the earlier directions of this Court and pass a reasoned order with proper reasons.

The order shall be passed within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of communication of this order. The writ petitioner is directed to personally serve a copy of this order on respondent Nos. 3 and 4 and file proof of the same within one week. Upon the respondent No.4 passing the reasoned order, an Affidavit shall be filed by the Respondent No.3 confirming passing of the order by Respondent No.4 within two (02) weeks thereafter.

List the matter on 10.08.2022."
