	15.05.2026	<p><u>GTK,J</u></p> <p>Heard Sri Ancha Panduranga Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri Shaik Abdul, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Roads and Buildings for the respondents.</p> <p>Embittered with the action of the respondents, in deviating the original alignment of National Highway-165 and encroaching upon the petitioner's land in Sy.No.84/1A at Peddapalaparru Village, Mudinepalli Mandal, as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner argued the case as reflected in the affidavit, stating that the encroachment now sought to be made by the respondents is contrary to the Gazette Notification and that any such deviation would be contrary to law.</p> <p>On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader, through instructions, dated 14.05.2026, received from the Deputy Executive Engineer duly signed, submitted that no land in Sy.No.84/1A is required for execution of the present</p>	

road work and that the same was only proposed for acquisition. The ongoing road work is being executed strictly within the acquired extent in Survey No.84/1B only.

It is further asserted that the respondents are not acting contrary to the prayer made in the Writ Petition and that they have no intention whatsoever to acquire or utilize any additional extent of land in Sy.No.84/1A.

The said instructions, which are now placed before this Court, shall form part and parcel of the present order.

In view of the said undertaking, the grievance of the petitioner stands addressed. It is further clarified that, as per the instructions, the respondents shall abstain from deviating from Gazette Notification No.1624 in S.O.No.1821(E), dated 24.05.2019.
