Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.4 in attempting to dispossess me from the land in an extent of Ac.0.90 cents in Sy.No.137/1A of Vijayapuram Village & Mandal, Chittoor District stating the same is required for the purpose of laying road, without putting me on notice and without adhering to due process of law, as arbitrary, illegal, contrary to the well established legal principles, apart from being violative of the fundamental and the Constitutional rights guaranteed to us under Articles, 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.4 not to dispossess me from the land in an extent of Ac.0.90 cents in Sy.No.137/1A of Vijayapuram Village Mandal Chittoor District;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in pursuance of the proceedings in ROC.No.14/2025, dated 25.04.2025 issued by the respondent No.9, Pending disposal of WP 14526 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V R REDDY KOVURI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR AGRICULTURE for Respondent Nos.1 to 8, Mrs.G.Rajeswari, Standing counsel for R9 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Agriculture appearing for the respondents.

The petitioner has been in possession of the premises belonging to the 9th respondent from the year 2010 onwards. By virtue of the proceedings dated 25.04.2026, the petitioner was directed to vacate the premises within 30 days from the date of receipt of the said proceedings. The petitioner received the said proceedings on 29.04.2026. From the said date onwards, the petitioner is entitled to continue in possession of the premises as a lessee for a period of 30 days.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings issued by the 9th respondent vide Roc.No.14 of 2025, dated 25.04.2026, pending disposal of the writ petition.

After expiry of the said period of 30 days, the 9th respondent is at liberty to proceed with the public auction, in which the petitioner shall also be entitled to participate, without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner in the present writ petition.

Respondent Nos.2 to 9 are at liberty to file counter affidavits.
