one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus - i)declaring the action of the 4th respondent in not entering my name in Online Revenue Records/Web Land Revenue Records by deleting the name of 6th respondent against my Land in Sy.No.1B/5 to an extent of Ac.4.22 cents situated at Rajupalem Revenue Village, Veerapunayunipalle Mandal, Kadapa District which I have been in peaceful possession and enjoyment and in spite of making representation dt.09-01-2023 as illegal, arbitrary, discriminative, mala fide, unjust, colorable exercise of powers besides violative of the Arts.14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India. and ii)consequently, direct the 4th respondent to consider my representation dt.09 01-2023 in order to enter my name in Online Revenue Records/Web Land Revenue Records by deleting the name of 6th respondent's name against my land in Sy.No.18/5 to an extent of Ac.4.22 cents situated at Rajupalem Revenue Village, Veerapunayunipalle Mandal, Kadapa District which I have been in peaceful possession and enjoyment.

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed seeking to declare the action of respondent No.4 in not entering the name of the petitioner in the Revenue Records/Web Land Revenue Records by deleting the name of 6th respondent over the land to an extent of Ac.4.22 cents in Sy.No.18/5 situated in Rajupalem Revenue Village, Veerpunayunipalle Mandal, Kadapa District as illegal and arbitrary.

Petitioner claims his right to the property as successor and that the Revenue Records have previously shown the name of the petitioner's grand-father as well as father subsequently. A representation dated 09.01.2023 was made to the Tahsildar i.e. 4th respondent herein for the said relief.

Though notice was given to the respondents, no counter has been filed.

Therefore, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition directing the Tahsildar to consider the representation dated 09.01.2023 and pass appropriate orders thereon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions if any shall stand dismissed.
