Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondent Nos.2 to 6 in attempting to dispossess the petitioners from the land in Sy.No.203/1A of Nadimuru Revenue Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District an extent of Ac 7.59 cents, covered by D-Form Patta / DKT No.871-4-80, Patta No.5, and in attempting to allot / hand over the said land to the unofficial respondents/solar project authorities without issuing notice, without conducting enquiry, without initiating lawful acquisition/resumption proceedings and without following due process of law, as illegal, arbitrary, high handed, violative of principles of natural justice and contrary to Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners over the subject land except by following due process of law.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent Nos.2 to 6 not to dispossess the petitioners from the land in Sy.No.203/1A of Nadimuru Revenue Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District an extent of Ac 7.59 cents, covered by D-Form Patta / DKT No.871-4-80, Patta No.5, and not to interfere with the petitioners' peaceful possession and enjoyment over the subject land, including the agricultural operations and small sheet house existing therein, and not to allot / hand over the said land to the unofficial respondents / solar project authorities, pending disposal of WP 15067 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Kode Ramesh Babu, Advocate for the Petitioners and of GP FOR REVENUE for Respondent Nos. 1 to 6, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

At the request of the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, list on 04.06.2026.

In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners of the subject land.”
