Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondent Nos.2 to 4 and their subordinate officials in trying to dispossess the petitioner from the subject land situated in old Sy.No.34/6B corresponding to LPM Nos. 310 of Thumsi Village, Santhipuram Mandal, Chittoor District, at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 8, without issuing notice, without passing any order, without considering the survey report dated 23-05- 2026 and without following due process of law, as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and principles of natural justice, and consequently direct the respondent authorities not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment over the subject land except by following due process of law, and further direct the respondent authorities to consider and take appropriate action on the survey report dated 23-05-2026 and the petitioner's grievance/representation for correction of extent variation in accordance with law.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct respondent Nos.2 to 4 and their subordinate officials not to dispossess the petitioner or interfere with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment over the subject land situated in old Sy.No.34/6B corresponding to LPM Nos.310 of Thumsi Village, Santhipuram

Mandal, Chittoor District, at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 8 or otherwise, without following due process of law, Pending disposal of WP 15069 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI KODE RAMESH BABU Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR REVENUE, for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, the Court made the following
