The Court made the following order:

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondents 7 & 8 by speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry.

The above writ petition was filed to direct the respondents 2 to 6 to mark the road on the Southern side instead of Northern side at Gopavaram Village, Kaikaluru Mandal, Eluru District, in pursuance of the notification No.SO.3488 (E), dated 25.08.2021 issued by respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that respondents 2 & 3 with the assistance of respondent No.6, attempted to demolish some part of the structure of the petitioners on 22.05.2026.

Sri Anand, learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondents 2 & 3 would submit that the competent authority is Roads & Buildings National Highway Division. In respect of alignment, respondent No.1 is the competent authority.

Sri Sanjeev, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents 4 to 6, on oral instructions would submit that the Tahsildar, Kaikalur Mandal, has not attempted to demolish the petitioners structures as alleged.

As seen from the material available on record, the notification filed by the petitioners along with the material papers Ex P.2, is dated 25.08.2021. No information is forthcoming regarding the subsequent developments stipulated as per Section 3 of the National Highways Act, 1956.

Given the facts and circumstances of the case, learned counsel for the petitioners shall take necessary steps to implead the proper respondents to the writ petition. The learned counsels appearing for the respondents shall get information regarding the developments, in pursuance of Ex P.2.

List the matter on 04.06.2026.
