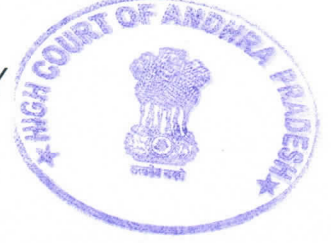

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, preferably one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, to declare the action of Respondent

No.5 in trying to evict the Petitioner from land to an extent of Ac.0.03 cents situated in Assessment no.278/R.S.127, Kondiparru village and Panchayat, Pamarru Mandal, Pamarru Taluk, Krishna District as illegal, arbitrary, unsustainable, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to set aside the impugned Notice vide Rc.DT/23/2026, dt. 26.05.2026.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.5 not to dispossess the Petitioner No.1 from land to an extent of Ac.0.03 cents situated in Assessment no.278/R.S.127 , Kondiparru village & Panchayat, Pamarru Mandal, Pamarru Taluk, Krishna District, Pending disposal of WP 15073 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI NALLURI SAHITHI APARNA Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos.1 & 3 to 5, GP FOR STAMPS & REGISTRATION for Respondent No.2, the Court made the following.
