Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of respondents, particularly the respondents 4 and 5 in insisting petitioner to vacate from her agriculture landed property admeasuring an extent of Ac.0.60 cents out of Ac. 2.30 cents in Survey No. 101/2 of Gundrajukuppam Revenue Village in Nagari Mandal of Chittoor District, at the instance of local political leaders without following any known procedure established by law, as illegal, irregular, irrational, without

jurisdiction and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere in any manner with petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment over her said landed property.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere in any manner with petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment over her agriculture landed property admeasuring an extent of Ac.0.60 cents out of Ac. 2.30 cents in Survey No. 101/2 of Gundrajukuppam Revenue Village in Nagari Mandal of Chittoor District, Pending disposal of WP 15080 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI RAJENDRA C Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR REVENUE, for the Respondent Nos.1 to 5, the Court made the following

In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner of the subject land.
