That apart, it is submitted that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners 1 and 2. Considering the same, there shall be stay of appearance of the petitioners herein in C.C.No.1748 of 2023 on the file of I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa, except for the dates when the presence of the petitioners is required, as directed by the learned Magistrate, for the purpose of trial.
