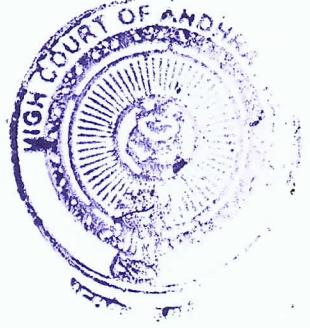

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023(Section 482 of Cr.P.C), praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all the further proceedings including the personal appearance of the petitioners in CC.No. 1748 of 2023 on the file of 1st Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st class, court, Kadapa, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 6077 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

“The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are arrayed as accused Nos.2 to 5 in C.C.No.1748 of 2023. It is submitted that the petitioners 1 and 2 are the mother-in-law and father-in-law of the 2nd respondent and the 3rd petitioner is the brother-inlaw and the 4th petitioner is the husband of the 3rd petitioner. It is submitted that after the marriage of the 3rd petitioner with the 4th petitioner, they have been living separately and are completely unconnected with the marital disputes between the 1st accused and the 2nd respondent. That apart, it is submitted that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners 1 and 2.

Considering the same, there shall be stay of appearance of the petitioners herein in C.C.No.1748 of 2023 on the file of 1 Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa, except for the dates when the presence of the petitioners is required, as directed by the learned Magistrate, for the purpose of trial.”
