WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri M.Sapthagiri, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent authorities, particularly Respondent Nos.3 and 4, in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner

over the scheduled property situated in Survey No.93-3 admeasuring Ac.0.35 cents in Duvvada Village, Gajuwaka Mandal, Visakhapatnam District, at the instigation of the unofficial respondent No.5, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said land except by following due process of law;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.Sapthagiri, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP for Revenue for Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and of GP for Home for Respondent No.4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

At request of the learned Government Pleader for Revenue, for obtaining instructions, post on 22.06.2026.

In the meanwhile, respondents 3 and 4 are directed not to disposses the petitioner from the land measuring Ac.0.35 cents situated in Sy.No.93-3 of Duvvada Village, Gajuwaka Mandal, Visakhapatnam District.”

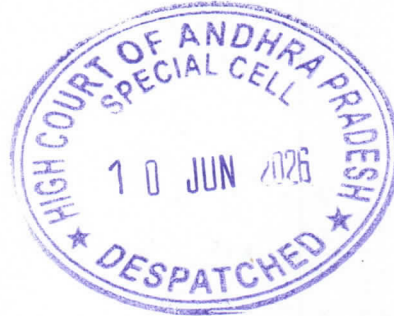
