Sri Bhagat Singh, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on written instructions, submits that the revenue authorities did not make any markings on the structures of the petitioners.

In the meantime, respondents 3 and 4 shall not take any coercive steps with regard to the structures of the petitioners situated in Sy.No.370, Ward No.2, R&B Road, Veligandla Village and Mandal, Markapur District.
