WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri P.Nagendra Reddy, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent No.2 in disconnecting the power supply to the function hall of the petitioner named H.Convention, Mayaluru village,

Uyyalawada mandal, Nandyal District without passing any orders and without following due process of law as arbitrary, illegal and violation of Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.2 to restore the power supply to the function hall of the petitioner named H.Convention, Mayaluru village, Uyyalawada mandal, Nandyal District forthwith in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.Nagendra Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Sri K.V.Ramana, Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and of GP for Energy for Respondent No.3 and of Sri Mattegunta Sudhir, Standing Counsel for Respondent No.4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
