Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or orders or direction or a writ one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents more particularly respondent No.3 and 4 in interfering and trying to dispossess the petitioners from the peaceful possession and enjoyment of petitioners property to an extent of Ac.20 cents in Survey No.47/2 of Peddasetti Palle Village and Gram Panchayat, Proddatur Mandal, YSR (Kadapa) District for laying a road through the petitioners land without following the procedure and due process of law is

illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents and their sub-ordinates not to dispose and interfere with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property to an extent of Ac.20 cents in Survey No.47/2 of Peddasetti Palle Village and Gram Panchayat, Proddatur Mandal, YSR (Kadapa) District;

**IA NO: 1 OF 2026:**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.3 and 4 not to interfere and dispose the petitioner from the petitioners' property to an extent of Ac.20 cents in Survey No.47/2 of Peddasetti Palle Village and Gram Panchayat, Proddatur Mandal, YSR (Kadapa) District, pending disposal of WP.No.15285 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Shaik Mohammed Ismail, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Panuku Rajesh Kumar, learned Assistant GP for Panchayat Raj for Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Ms.Kavitha, learned counsel representing Sri M.Sudhir, learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent No.4, the Court made the following;

**ORDER:**

Heard Sri Shaik Mohammed Ismail, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri Panuku Rajesh Kumar, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj appearing for respondents 1 to 3 and Ms.Kavitha, learned counsel representing Sri M.Sudhir, learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner, along with two others, purchased the land of an extent of Ac.0.20 cents in Sy.No.47/2 of Peddasetti Palle Village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR District, by a registered sale deed bearing document No.8345 of 2012, dated 11.10.2012. The petitioner and other co-purchasers constructed residential houses. The local authority assigned D.Nos.6/195, 6/196 &

6/197. The petitioner and others have been houses tax to the local authority. The subordinates of respondents 3 & 4, attempted to demolish the house bearing D.no.6/196, without issuing any notice. The petitioner made a representation dated 31.05.2026 (Ex.P5) to respondent No.3. Again, on 03.06.2026 & 05.06.2026, the subordinates of respondent No.4, attempted to lay a road by dispossessing the petiitoner, without following the due procedure of law.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader and learned Standing Counsel seek time to get instructions or to file a counter-affidavit.

Given the facts and circumstances of the case, respondents 3 & 4 shall not interfere with the petitioner's possession and enjoyment of the house bearing D.No.6-196 of Peddasetti Palle Village, Proddatur Mandal, YSR District, without following due procedure of law, for a period of four (04) weeks.
