Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue an appropriate writ or order more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the official respondents especially respondents 5 and 6 who are threatening the petitioners and their family members with dire consequences upon the instance of unofficial respondent No. 7 by forcing the petitioners to vacate the property in Sy.No.798/12 of Anakapalli, Anakapalli District to an extent of Ac.1.40 cents which is arbitrary, illegal, against the Principles of Natural Justice and contrary to the Article No. 14,19,21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and to declare the same as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, biased, discriminatory and also in violation of principles of natural justice apart from violation of Articles 14,19,21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents 5 and 6 not to interfere with the peaceful possession of the petitioners and to pass

This Writ Petition is filed by the petitioners seeking restraint of respondents 5 and 6 in interfering with the civil dispute between the parties with respect of Ac.1.40 cents of land in Sy.No.798/12 of Anakapalli District at the instance of 7th respondent.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondent-police.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on written instructions, would submit that when the 5th petitioner approached the police seeking resolution of dispute and he was advised to approach the civil Court considering the dispute as civil in nature and they stand by the same in respect of all the parties.

4. Recording the representation made by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, the Writ Petition is closed as no further orders are necessary. Instructions shall form part of record. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
