Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the Notice No./AEE/Y.I.Section.No.1/ Pitapuram/20 P dt.06.06.2026 granting 72 hours (3 days) time to remove the road and pipes is illegal, arbitrary and violation of principles of natural justice and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India and to consequently set aside the same

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the Notice No./AEE/Y.I.Section.No.1/ Pitapuram/20 P dt.06.06.2026 issued by the 3rd respondent, Pending disposal of WP 15310 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V V Satish Advocate for the Petitioner(s), Government Pleader for IRRI &CAD for the Respondents and the Court made the following

ORDER

“Learned Government Pleader for IRRI &CAD, on written instructions, states that the petitioner laid a Tumma Kaluva in Kandarada Village, Pithapuram Mandal, contrary to the proceedings issued by the 2nd respondent, dated 20.09.2024. He would further submit that, under the said proceedings, the 2nd respondent had specifically permitted the petitioner to construct a slab culvert. However, instead of constructing the slab culvert as permitted, the petitioner laid cement pipes and formed a road thereon, which is contrary to the terms and conditions of the permission granted by the 2nd respondent.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks some time to remove the road and cement pipes laid across the Tumma Kaluva and undertakes that the petitioner shall construct a slab culvert in accordance with the permission granted by the 2nd respondent.

3. At his request , post on 29.06.2026.

4. In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall construct a slab culvert across the Tumma Kaluva situated at Kondarada Village, Pithapuram Mandal, Kakinada District, strictly in compliance with the proceedings issued by the 2nd respondent, dated 06.06.2026.

5. Till then, the respondents are directed not to take any coercive steps in respect of the said Tumma Kaluva.”
