01	11.06.2026	<p><b><u>KSR,J</u></b></p> <p>Questioning the notice issued by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in No.2/G/1323/2026, dated 26.05.2026, asking the petitioners to appear before him on 11.06.2026 at about 3.30 p.m., for verification of the records and documents, stating that the petitioners created fake and fabricated documents <i>vide</i> document Nos.8589 of 2019, and 29603 of 2024 on the file of the Joint Sub-Registrar, Kurnool SRO, Kurnool, for the land admeasuring an extent of Ac. 2.58 cents in survey No.92 of Dinnedavarapadu Village, Kurnool Mandal, Kurnool District, the present writ petition is filed by way of lunch motion.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that respondent No.3 has no jurisdiction to issue such notice.</p> <p>On the other hand, the learned Government Pleader for Revenue produced written instructions of the District Registrar, Kurnool District, dated 11.06.2026. In the written instructions, it is stated that the enquiry was initiated pursuant to the complaint under Section</p>	

77-A of the Registration Act and it is still in progress and no final orders have been passed.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue for respondent Nos.1 and 2 as well as learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.5 and learned counsel for respondent No.7 seek time to file their counters.

At their request, post the matter after two (2) weeks.

Till then, respondent No.3 is directed not to pass any final orders in the matter, but the proceedings and enquiry may go on.
