Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or an order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent authorities particularly the 4th and 5th respondent herein in trying to dispossess the petitioners from their lands in an extent of Ac.1.78 cents in Sy.No.52. Ac.0.62 cents in Sy.No.52-2 and Ac. 0.52 cents in Sy.No.52-1 totaling to an extent of Ac.2.92 cents situated in Kalaparru Village, Pedapadu Mandal, Eluru District, without following due process of law and without passing orders subsequent to the notice issued on 19.12.2025 as highly arbitrary, illegal, null and void and against the principles of natural justice and violative of fundamental rights apart from the Article 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently to direct the respondent authorities

- a. not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioner over the above said lands in an extent of Ac.1.78 cents in Sy.No.52, Ac.0.62 cents in Sy.No.52-2 and Ac. 0.52 cents in Sy.No.52-1 totaling to an extent of Ac.2.92 cents situated in Kalaparru Village, Pedapadu Mandal, Eluru District,
- b. not to mutate 6th and 7th respondents names in the revenue records by deleting the names of the petitioners herein,
- c. not to enter the subject properties owned by the petitioners in list of prohibited properties under 22A(1)(C).

Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent authorities not to mutate 6th and 7th respondents names in the revenue records by deleting the names of the petitioners herein and not to enter the subject properties owned by the petitioners in list of prohibited properties under 22A(1)(C) without following

due process of law, pending disposal of WP 15373 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Durga Mahindra Ponnamm, Advocate for the Petitioners and of GP FOR REVENUE for Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and of GP FOR ENDOWMENTS for Respondent No.5 and of Ms. Pulipati Radhika, Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos.6 and 7, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Learned Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice for respondent Nos.1 to 4.

Learned Government Pleader for Endowments takes notice for respondent No.5.

Ms. Pulipati Radhika, learned Standing Counsel takes notice for respondent Nos.6 and 7.

At their request, post the matter on 18.06.2026.

Till then, the respondents are directed not to dispossess the petitioners from the land admeasuring an extent of Ac. 1.78 cents in survey No.52, Ac. 0.62 cents in survey No.52-2 and Ac. 0.52 cents in survey No.52-1, totalling an extent of Ac. 2.92 cents situated at Kalaparru Village, Pedapadu Mandal, Eluru District. It is also made clear that the petitioners are also directed not to make any constructions and not to create any third party interest thereon.”
