2.	25.07.2025	<u>TRR, J</u> Lok Adalat at Chirala <i>vide</i> order dated 31.12.2005 passed an award under Section 21 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 by dissolving the marriage between the petitioner herein and respondent in O.P.No.43 of 2004. However, the respondent-wife has again filed H.M.O.P.No.120 of 2022 on the file of learned Senior Civil Judge, Chirala, under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking to dissolve the marriage between petitioner and respondent solemnized on 21.05.1989. Petitioner herein filed I.A.No.1192 of 2023 in H.M.O.P.No.120 of 2022 under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure to reject the O.P., the said petition was dismissed <i>vide</i> order dated 07.04.2025. Aggrieved by the same, the present revision petition is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. Learned counsel for the petitioner insisted on passing of an interim order, by way of granting a stay of proceedings in the said H.M.O.P. This Court is not inclined to grant any	

		interim order for the reason that marriage was already dissolved by Lok Adalat in award dated 31.12.2005. Though principle of res judicata applies, it does not cause prejudice to the petitioner since the marriage was already dissolved, once again respondent seeking divorce. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he filed proof of service memo in the Registry <i>vide</i> U.S.R.No.78440 of 2025. Office is directed to verify and place the same in the bundle. List the matter after one week. TRR,J KBN	
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
