Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present H.M.O.P.No.120 of 2022 is filed on the file of Court of the Senior Civil Judge, Chirala is liable to be rejected on the ground of principle of <i>res-judicata</i>. He further submits that the petitioner and respondent herein have settled their matrimonial disputes and were already separated <i>vide</i> a lokadalath award dated 31.12.2005 passed in O.P.No.43	

		of 2004 filed by the petitioner. Even though an award was already passed by the Lokadalath on 31.12.2005 and allowed to become final and suppressing the very fact, the respondent in O.P.No.43 of 223 filed present H.M.O.P. No.120 of 2022 seeking again divorce is contrary to law and against the principle of <i>res-judicata</i>. In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the material placed on record, particularly, award dated 31.12.2005 passed by the Lokadalath, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings in H.M.O.P.No.120 of 2022 on the file of Court of the Senior Civil Judge, Chirala, till the next of hearing.
