He was charged for the offence punishable under Section 34(A) of the Andhra Pradesh Excise Act, 1968 and the same is pending before the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge's Court, Piler, Chittoor District vide C.C.No.189 of 2022.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the petitioner (A4) submits that the charge sheet does not disclose commission of any offence by A4 and contains only omnibus allegations against him. Even according to the charge sheet, the allegations relate only to A1 and A2. As the trial is going on, the petitioner (A4) now seeks dispensation of his personal appearance before the trial Court to enable him to attend to his day to day activities.</p> <p>5.
