1.	19.06.2026	<p><u>SRK, J</u></p> <p>Notice before admission, returnable in three (3) weeks.</p> <p>Heard learned counsel for petitioners and learned counsel appearing for respondents.</p> <p>Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the respondent authorities are directing the petitioners to vacate the business premises without affording any reasonable time or opportunity and without following due process of law.</p> <p>Learned counsel for respondents submits that despite the issuance of notice, the petitioners are not paying the rents for shops occupied by them.</p> <p>On the other hand, learned counsel for petitioners submits that in the earlier Writ Petition filed by them, they categorically mentioned that they are ready to pay the rents, but the respondent authorities are not accepting the same for the reasons best known to them.</p> <p>In view of the same, the petitioners are permitted to pay the due rents to the respondent authorities. The respondent authorities are directed not to evict the petitioners herein without following the due process of law.</p>
