Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue the Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ by declaring the acts of Respondent Nos.2 to 3 in threatening the Petitioner to surrender his original registered document bearing Doc No.17473/2024 Dt.,28.06.2024 and to unconditionally hand over his document scheduled property to the Respondent Nos.4 to 9 as illegal, arbitrary, abuse of process of Law and hit by Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300- A of the Constitution of India and consequently to direct Respondents to not to interfere with the Petitioners property scheduled in the document in contravention to the due process of Law.

4. Having regard to the nature of the matter, it is indicated that no further adjournment will be granted for completion of pleadings.

6. Interim Order granted on 22.07.2024 shall continue till the next listing."
