Taking into consideration of the above submissions coupled with the facts and circumstances in the lis, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/Accused No.4 in C.C.No.1199 of 2022 on the file of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Nandyal, for a period of twelve (12) weeks.
