01.	18.06.2026	<p><b><u>HN,J</u></b></p> <p>The petitioners are in possession and enjoyment of 1 ½ cents of land each, and they have constructed their houses and are living therein. It is submitted that the concerned Tahsildar had also issued Residential Site Possession Certificates in the year 2011 itself, duly recognizing the possession and enjoyment of the petitioners for the past twelve years prior to issuance of the Residential Site Possession Certificate. It is submitted that the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent has issued the impugned proceedings branding the petitioners as encroachers, and an Encroachment Notice dated 20.05.2026 has been issued. It is submitted that the petitioners are apprehending dispossession from their properties.</p> <p>The learned Standing counsel appearing for respondent No.4, on oral instructions, submits that the petitioners have submitted their Residential Site Possession Certificate along with other documents in response to the Encroachment Notice. It is submitted that the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent has forwarded the Residential Site Possession Certificates as submitted by the petitioners to the concerned Tahsildar for verification. It is submitted that appropriate orders shall be passed after receipt of the information. Insofar as respondent No.4 is concerned, the subject property forms part and parcel of a weaker section layout. It is submitted that the respondents shall pass appropriate orders in</p>	

pursuance to the replies received by the petitioners, soon after receiving appropriate information from the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent.

Post this matter on 23.07.2026.

In the meanwhile, there shall be in interim direction not to dispossess the petitioners.
