This application is filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 challenging the order dated 23.02.2026 passed in CrI.M.P.No.924 of 2025 in M.C.No.27 of 2025 on the file of Judge, Family Court-cum-VIII Additional District & Sessions Judge at Ongole, Prakasam District. 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that respondent No.1/wife filed a petition under Section 144(1) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for interim maintenance which was allowed by the learned Judge, Family Court-cum-XII Additional District & Sessions Judge at Ongole, Prakasam District, granting Rs.10,000/- to the petitioner No.1/wife and Rs.7,000/- each to the petitioner Nos.2 to 4/children per month from the date of petition on or before 10th of every succeeding month. 3. Learned counsel asserted that in view of the petitioner's age as well as his ailments, he is not able to pay such amount at this juncture. He also contends that before ordering interim maintenance he has taken care the needs of his	

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		children. 4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the order dated 23.02.2026 passed in Crl.M.P.No.924 of 2025 in M.C.No.27 of 2025 on the file of Judge, Family Court-cum-VIII Additional District & Sessions Judge at Ongole, Prakasam District, on condition to deposit Rs.8,000/- to the respondent No.1 and Rs.5,000/- each to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 per month from the date of petition on or before 10th of every succeeding month. Petitioner is further directed to deposit the arrears if any corresponding by calculating the above stated amount within four (04) weeks from today, failing which this order shall be stands vacated automatically. <u>Crl.P.No.4867 of 2026</u> 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent Nos.1 to 4 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service into the Registry. 6.
