COMMON JUDGMENT: *(per Hon'ble Sri Justice Ravi Nath Tilhari)*

The petition filed by the husband seeking divorce in O.P.No.14 of 2004 was dismissed, whereas O.P.No.20 of 2001 filed by the wife seeking restitution of conjugal rights was allowed by a common judgment dated 24.08.2007. Aggrieved thereby, the husband has filed the present appeals.
