Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the unofficial respondent No.2 through Speed Post with acknowledgement due/Email/WhatsApp, in accordance with ROC.No.165/2021-CPS, dated 17.04.2023, and file proof of service in the Registry. 5. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners herein (A2 to A6) have been roped into the <i>lis</i> solely to settle private scores. He further submits that the allegations levelled against the petitioners herein in the charge sheet are only omnibus in nature. 6. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, and considering that petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are aged about 60 and 61 years respectively and are suffering from various ailments,	

		and that the other petitioners are distant relatives of A1, coupled with the nature of the allegations levelled against them and in view of the well-settled principle laid down in <i>Geddani Jhansi Vs. State of Telangana</i>¹, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings in C.C. No.60 of 2026 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Parchur, insofar as the petitioners herein (A2 to A6) are concerned, for a period of eight (08) weeks. 7.
