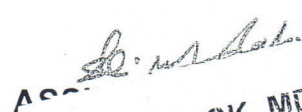
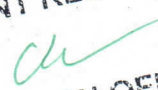
“Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice for respondent No.1 and seeks time to get instructions in the matter.
