05.07.2006 on the file of the IV Addl. Munsif Magistrate, Guntur in C.C.No. 579/2004 for the offence punishable under Sec.138 of N.I.Act and sentencing him to undergo S.I. for a period of three months and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- in default S.I. for one month, pending disposal of CRLRC 493 of 2008, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memorandum of grounds filed in support thereof and the earlier orders of the High Court dated 31.03.2008 made in CrI.R.C.M.P.No.681 of 2008 & 28.01.2025 and Sri M.Pitchaiah, Counsel for the Petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.2, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not in touch with the office inspite of best efforts made by them.

Issue Non Bailable Warrant against the revisionist A.Amaranadh Babu, S/o.Keva Naik, 48 years, R/o.Kattempudi village, Ponnur Mandal, Guntur District, through the Superintendent of Police Guntur. On his arrest, he shall be produced before the leaned IV Additional Munsif Magistrate, Guntur. On the arrest, the accused/revisionist/petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten Thousand only) with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned IV Additional Munsif Magistrate, Guntur. The petitioner shall file an affidavit before the leaned IV Additional Munsif Magistrate, Guntur that he would engage a counsel and give necessary instructions to his counsel to prosecute the revision.

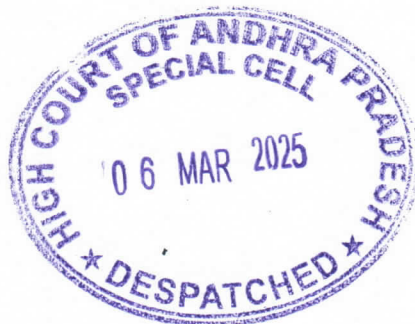

On such production, if the said Revision Petitioner furnishes a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of **the IV Additional Munsif Magistrate, Guntur**, he shall be released on bail.

You are also directed to return this warrant as early as possible preferably on or before **01.04.2025** to this Court with a detailed report stating the manner in which it has been executed.

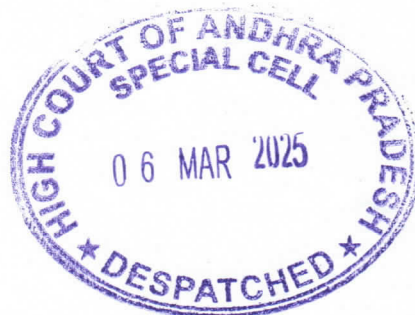
