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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to immediately produce the detenue namely Mallela Ganga @ Ganga before this Hon'ble Court and further direct the respondents not to subject her to any physical or mental harassment, torture or coercion, pending disposal of the above writ petition and pass
