WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri K Venkatesh presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in not taking any steps to prevent the respondents 3 and 4 from making illegal constructions in my land as wholly illegal, arbitrary and unjust and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to consider and dispose of my representations 16.06.2022 and 22.06.2022 forthwith by restraining the respondents 3 and 4 from making constructions in my land in an extent of 18 cents 33 links situate Sy.No.364/B1A in Nandyal Town, Kurnool District in the interest of justice;

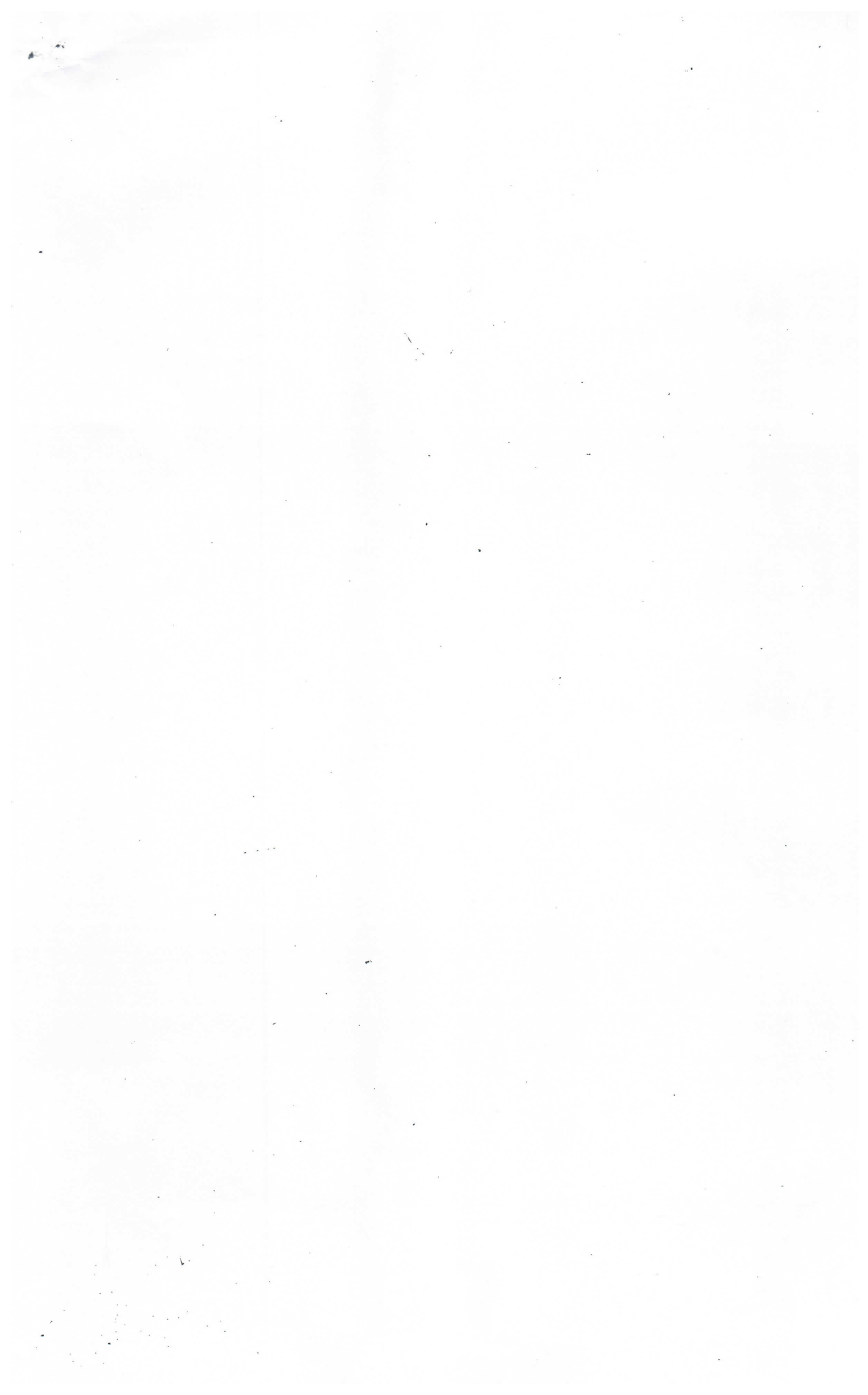
