WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P SRI RAM presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be to issue a direction, order or writ more particularly a writ in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring that the orders passed in D.Dis.No.273/2021, dt: 26-3-2022 and signed on 30-3-2022 as being illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction and set aside the same thus confirm the section 3 order of the Primary Tribunal (6th respondent) dated 03.12.2020 and consequently direct the 6th respondent to proceed under section 7 of the IA Act 1956 and pass appropriate orders by declaring that the proceedings under Estates abolition Act, 1948 as relating to the Sangivalasa Agraharam Village of Bheemunipatnam Mandal of Visakhapatnam District are null and void as the said Village is to be treated as an enfranchised Inam and not an Estate,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P SRI RAM Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR REVENUE for Respondents directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
