Petition under Section 430(1) of BNSS is filed praying that in the
circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the
High Court may be pleased to suspend the conviction Judgment dated
30.03.2026 passed by the VIII Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Vijayawada,

NTR District in Crl.Appeal.No.106 of 2025 confirming the conviction judgment dated 19.02.2025 passed in C.C.No.12/2024 by the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gannavaram, Krishna District, Pending disposal of CRLRC No. 659 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The petitioner/accused was not present when the learned Appellate Court passed judgment confirming the conviction and sentence imposed by the learned Trial Court.

The petitioner/accused is permitted to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gannavaram, within a period of one (01) week from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

On such surrender and filing of an application seeking enlargement on bail, the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gannavaram, shall release the petitioner on bail, subject to her executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gannavaram, on the same day itself.

Subject to the above compliance only the sentence of imprisonment imposed by the learned VIII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Vijayawada, vide order dated 30.03.2026 in Crl.A.No.106 of 2025 alone is suspended pending disposal of the Criminal Revision Case.

The petitioner shall deposit 20% of the cheque amount before the learned Trial Court within a period of six (06) weeks from this date.

On failure to deposit 20% of the cheque amount within the above stipulated period, the learned Trial Court is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law for recovery of the said amount.

On such deposit, respondent No.1 is at liberty to withdraw the same by producing sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court concerned.
