Post the matter after four weeks."

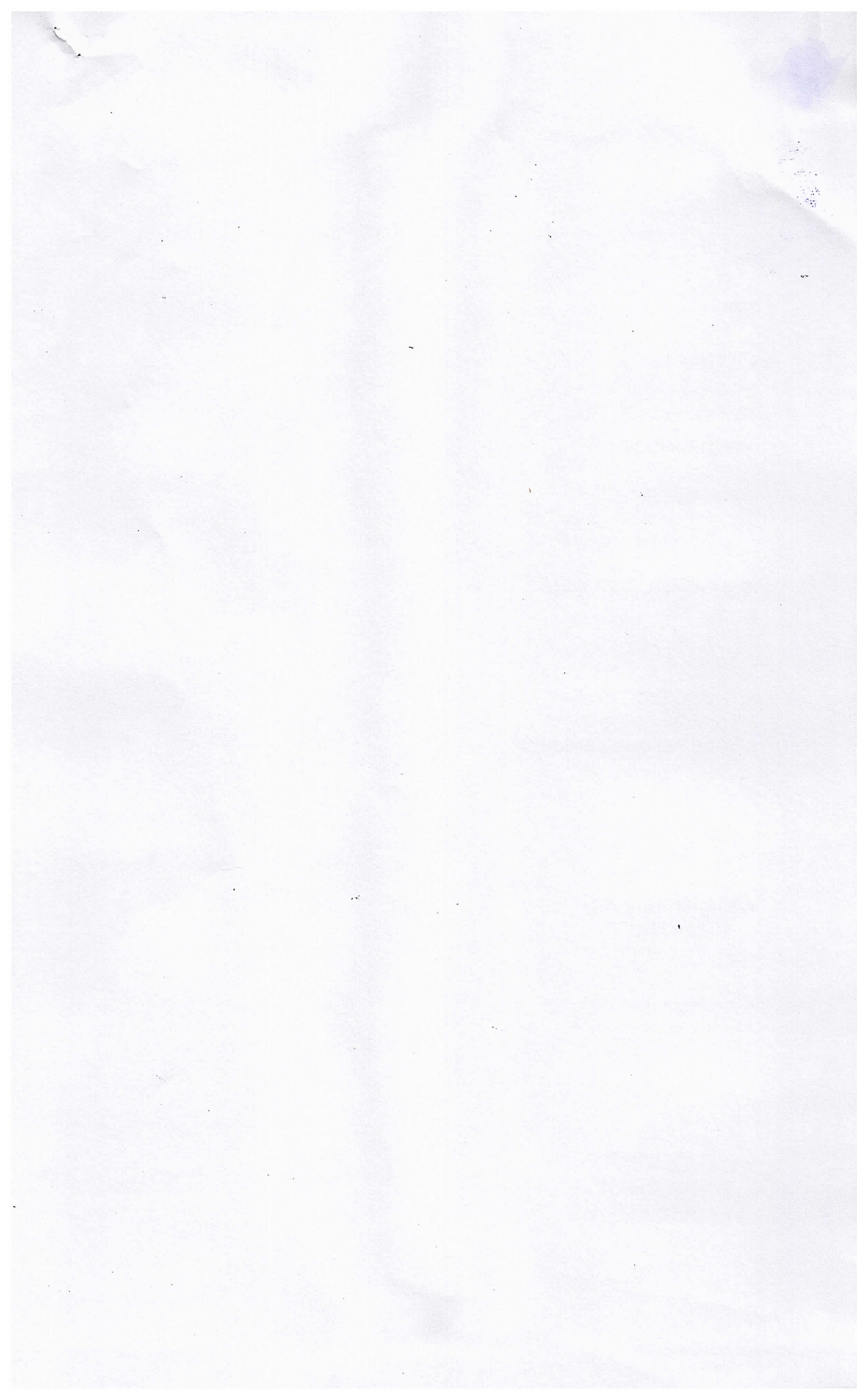
