The Court made the following order:

Aggrieved by the order and decree dated 09.05.2024 passed in Interlocutory Application No.258 of 2024 in Interlocutory Application No.610 of 2022 in Original Suit No.53 of 2021 on the file of the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Eluru, the present Civil Revision Petition is filed.

2. Sri Ch.Venkaiah, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that O.S.No.53 of 2021 has already been disposed of by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Eluru and nothing remains for adjudication and that the Civil Revision Petition has become infructuous.
