WHEREAS the Petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971, above case through his counsel Sri K.Sreedhar Murthy, praying that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to punish the respondents herein for deliberate and wilful disobedience of the orders in W.P.No.8841 of 2018, dated 25.07.2023;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for orders as to admission on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and the earlier order of the High Court dated. 09.07.2025, made herein upon hearing the arguments of Sri K.Sreedhar Murthy, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Sri Y.Balaji, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1 & 2, the Court made the following

**ORDER:**

The above contempt case was filed complaining violation of order dated 25.07.2023 in W.P.No.8441 of 2018.

The contempt case was listed on 20.12.2025 and docket order reads thus:

"Sri Rasheed, learned counsel, representing Sri Y. Balaji, learned counsel for the respondents, submitted that the assignment record was not available in the office of the Tahsildar or the District Collector and seeks time to comply with the order dated 25.07.2023 in W.P.No.8841 of 2018 in its letter and spirit."

Today when the matter is taken up for hearing, Sri Praveen, learned counsel representing Sri Y.Balaji, learned counsel for the respondents, submitted an endorsement vide Rc.B.282/2007, dated 08.01.2026. The said endorsement, in the considered opinion of this Court is nothing but reiteration of the averments in the counter affidavit filed by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent. *Prima facie*, this Court is of the considered opinion that the respondents violated the order dated 25.07.2023 in W.P.No.8441 of 2018 and the above contempt case needs to be admitted. However, in order to give one more opportunity, the respondents 1 and 2 are directed to appear before this Court in person along with entire record.

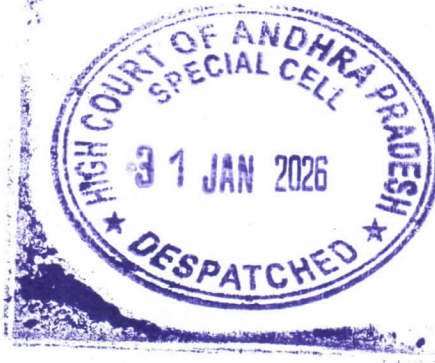
