ORDER:

The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed by the petitioner/Jdr aggrieved by the orders passed in E.P.No.23 of 2023 in O.S.No.72 of 2022 by the learned Senior Civil Judge, Dhoni.

2. When the matter is taken up for admission, Sri G.Sravan Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, restricting the relief sought in the revision, prayed this Court to direct the trial Court to dispose of the application filed by the petitioner/defendant vide in I.A.No.125 of 2024 by fixing some time. He further contended that the respondent herein filed suit vide in O.S.No.72 of 2022 on the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Dhoni, for recovery of money. The petitioner, who is the defendant, was set ex-parte and a decree was passed. To set aside the said decree, interlocutory application has been filed along with the delay petition and the same is pending adjudication. In the meantime, the plaintiff filed the present E.P.No.23 of 2023 seeking attachment of the defendant's salary. The petitioner is having a good case before the trial Court in O.S.No.72 of 2022 and it would suffice, for the time being, if a direction is given to dispose of the said interlocutory applications.

3. Ms.Ayesha Azma, learned counsel for the respondents, reported no objection for giving such direction.

4. Taking into consideration the submissions, instead of going into merits and demerits of the case in the present Civil Revision Petition, as relief sought is innocuous, this Court is inclined to dispose of this Civil Revision Petition directing the learned Senior Civil Judge to decide the petitioner's interlocutory application

vide in I.A.No.125 of 2024 in O.S.No.72 of 2022, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six (06) weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. The party shall cooperate with the enquiry.

5. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition is ***disposed of***. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
