2. Learned counsel for the petitioners asserts that the petitioners herein are A.2 to A.9 in Crime No.61 of 2026 of Malikipuram Police Station, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District and are in no way connected with the alleged matrimonial misunderstanding between the 2nd respondent and A.1. He also asserts that the petitioners have no nexus with the instant case and the very ingredients of the crime are not attracted to Section 82 (1) BNS 2023.
3. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, the respondent police are directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners, for a period of twelve (12) weeks, from today.
4. Post on 08.09.2026.

5. Meanwhile, learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on the 2nd respondent through SPAD and file proof of service in the Registry.
